



5. Only the IA chair and attending veterinarian can determine whether a protocol is exempt from oversight. The IA reserves the right to require that an approved protocol be reviewed prior to starting any research or teaching involving the use of animals if it determines that the interests of the university and/or the animals are in jeopardy.
6. If IA approval is required by a funding agency an exemption cannot be granted.
7. Activities assigned exempt status may be subject to re-evaluation by the IA for conditions including but not limited to changes in federal, state, local or institutional policy or changes in the scientific community.
